- 1. A cohort of consultant radiologists and reporting radiographers interpreted a bank of 106 adult chest X-rays with comparable accuracy.
- 2. Similar agreement was found between chest X-ray reports prvided by consultant radiologists and reporting radiographers at a single clinical site when compared to expert thoracic radiologists.
- 3. There was no apparent difference on how clinicians' used consultant radiologist and reporting radiographer chest X-ray reports when making diagnostic decisions.
