Project title: The EXPOSE Project: Exploring the Lived Experiences of Diagnostic Radiographers Performing Imaging Examinations for People from Prison in Acute Hospital Settings: A Mixed-Methods Study

About the research:

This PhD project explores the lived experiences of diagnostic radiographers who perform imaging examinations for people from prison in acute hospital settings in the UK. An anonymous online survey is being used to explore patterns, challenges, and support needs among diagnostic radiographers with relevant experience. This is followed by optional in-depth online interviews to gain a deeper understanding of how radiographers make sense of these

experiences.

Who can take part:

Diagnostic radiographers practising in the UK who have experience performing imaging examinations for people from prison in acute hospital settings.
