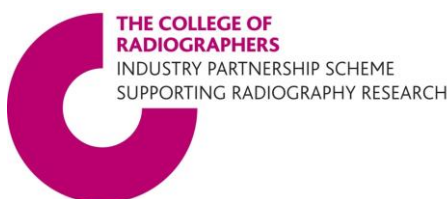

<p>Systematic review: Attitudes of oncology healthcare practitioners towards smoking cessation: a systematic review of the facilitators, barriers and recommendations for delivery of advice and support to cancer patients.</p> <p>Results: Delivery of cessation by oncology professionals was impacted by their own knowledge and views, their perception of the benefits to patient health and by the workplace procedures within their institution.</p> <p>46 pre questionnaires completed. 5 focus groups completed, transcribed and analysed. 27 post questionnaires received.</p>
